



Five-Minute Nature Play: Stone Writing

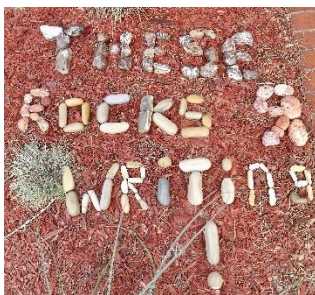
If you are like us, rocks just find their way into your pockets.
